Examining the Effects of Music-Based Rhythmic Auditory Stimulation (RAS) on Gait in Parkinson's Disease

- **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:** Parkinson's patients aged 50 years or older, who can speak English fluently, **walk independently (or with a cane)**, have normal (or corrected) hearing and vision, and are not suffering from any other neurological disorders (other than Parkinson's disease)
- **PROCEDURES INVOLVED:** Participants will visit our lab once, perform some music listening tasks, and walk on a specialized gait mat, while listening to various songs
- **DURATION:** 1.5 - 2 hours
- **COMPENSATION:** \$15 - 20 will be provided to participants
