For a study to examine the effectiveness of music therapy in detecting progression of Parkinson's disease



This study will involve:

- Attending a 30-minute music therapy and testing session (total of 90 minutes) where you will play on an electronic drum set (provided) with a graduate music therapy student playing the keyboard.
- You will have your cognitive ability, gait, and hand strength and dexterity clinically tested before the music therapy session.
- After the session, there will be a brief interview for you to share your experience during the session.
