The Music and Neuroscience Lab (Principal Investigator: Dr. Jessica Grahn) is looking for volunteers diagnosed with Parkinson's Disease to participate in a study exploring how non-invasive brain stimulation and music can influence movement. The study involves walking to musical stimuli while receiving brain stimulation. You will be compensated for your time.

The study will happen in two days, and it takes about 1h30min to be completed on each day at the Interdisciplinary Research Building (WIRB), at Western University, London, ON.

Recruiting participants:

- Diagnosed with Parkinson's Disease.
- Able to walk without support (e.g. walkers, etc) for around 20 minutes with breaks.
- No history of serious brain trauma; no deep brain stimulation (DBS) or pacemaker.
