



Do you have Parkinson's?

**We are seeking research volunteers to participate
in a video-based gait training program**

This study will involve you:

- Walking while mentally rehearsing verbal cues
- Completing some questionnaires
- Practicing your walking with a custom-made gait training video

To participate you must:

- Be diagnosed with Parkinson's disease (PD)
- Be able to walk independently and without a walking aid for at least 10mins
- Have no other cognitive or neurological impairments (e.g., brain tumors, recent concussion, stroke, brain injury)
- Be older than 40 years old
- Receive a minimum score of 24 on the Standardized Mini Mental State Examination (SMSSE) that will be completed on the first study visit.

Duration: ~1.5hrs 3-4 times on site and at-home practice (~15mins every other day) over 13-17 weeks

Location: Western Interdisciplinary Research Building (WIRB) on The University of Western Ontario campus in London, ON.
